

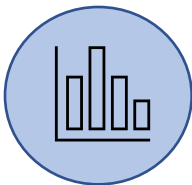


Hispanic Serving Institution Initiatives



TIMELINE

- 2018: UA becomes federally designated as a Hispanic Serving Institution
- 2018: UA appoints inaugural Assistant Vice Provost for HSI Initiatives
- 2018-2019: UA launches the HSI Fellows Program to strengthen HSI leadership capacity among UA faculty and staff
- 2019: UA is one of nine institutions awarded the Seal of Excelencia
- 2019: HSI Initiatives prioritized in UA Strategic Plan
- 2020: UA awarded Outstanding Member Institution by the Hispanic Association of Colleges & Universities
- 2020: Associate Vice Provost for Faculty Development hired
- 2020: UA awarded \$3M U.S. Department of Education Grant – Project Outreach FAMILIA
- 2021: UA launches AZ HSI Consortium
- 2021: UA awarded \$5M U.S. Department of Education Grant – Project CREAR
- 2021: Latinx Faculty & Staff Association launches
- 2022: UA becomes member of newly launched Alliance of Hispanic Serving Research Universities
- 2022: UA becomes recertified with the Seal of Excelencia
- 2022: UA Hispanic Alumni Club celebrates 40 year anniversary
