



- Declining Hispanic Enrollment in AZ Higher Education
 41.3% of H.S. grads enroll in H.E.
- Fewer University **degrees awarded** to Arizona residents

FAFSA OPENS LATE THIS YEAR

The 2024-2025 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) will open much later this year than in previous years. It is expected to open in December 2023. The delay this year is due to the time it takes to roll out changes required by the FAFSA Simplification Act.

AWC saw a five-year % change increase of about 24% of the total number of Baccalaureate degree recipients who entered as New Transfers while there was a -0.6% change decrease statewide.
