### **Arizona at Glance**

- Fall 2022 Incoming Class
  - Total Enrolled 11,939
  - Incoming First Year 9,091/ Transfer 2,848
  - First Year; Hispanic/Latinx 27.6%
  - Transfer; Hispanic/Latinx 32.1%
- Fall 2023 Incoming Class
  - Total Enrolled 12,463
  - Incoming First Year 9,178 / Transfer 3,285
  - First Year; Hispanic or Latinx 28.6%
  - Transfer; Hispanic or Latinx 31.2%



### **Arizona at Glance**

#### Fall 2024 Incoming Class

- First-year class enrollment numbers = approximately 9,300 have registered for classes! We expect this class to rival last year's historically large class...and at census, we expect to be even larger than last year.
- This year's first-year students are also part of the most diverse class in university history: 50% self-identify as ethnicities other than white, up from 49% last year. There was a 6% increase in Hispanic/Latinx students.
