# Name of Your Program (Group 2)

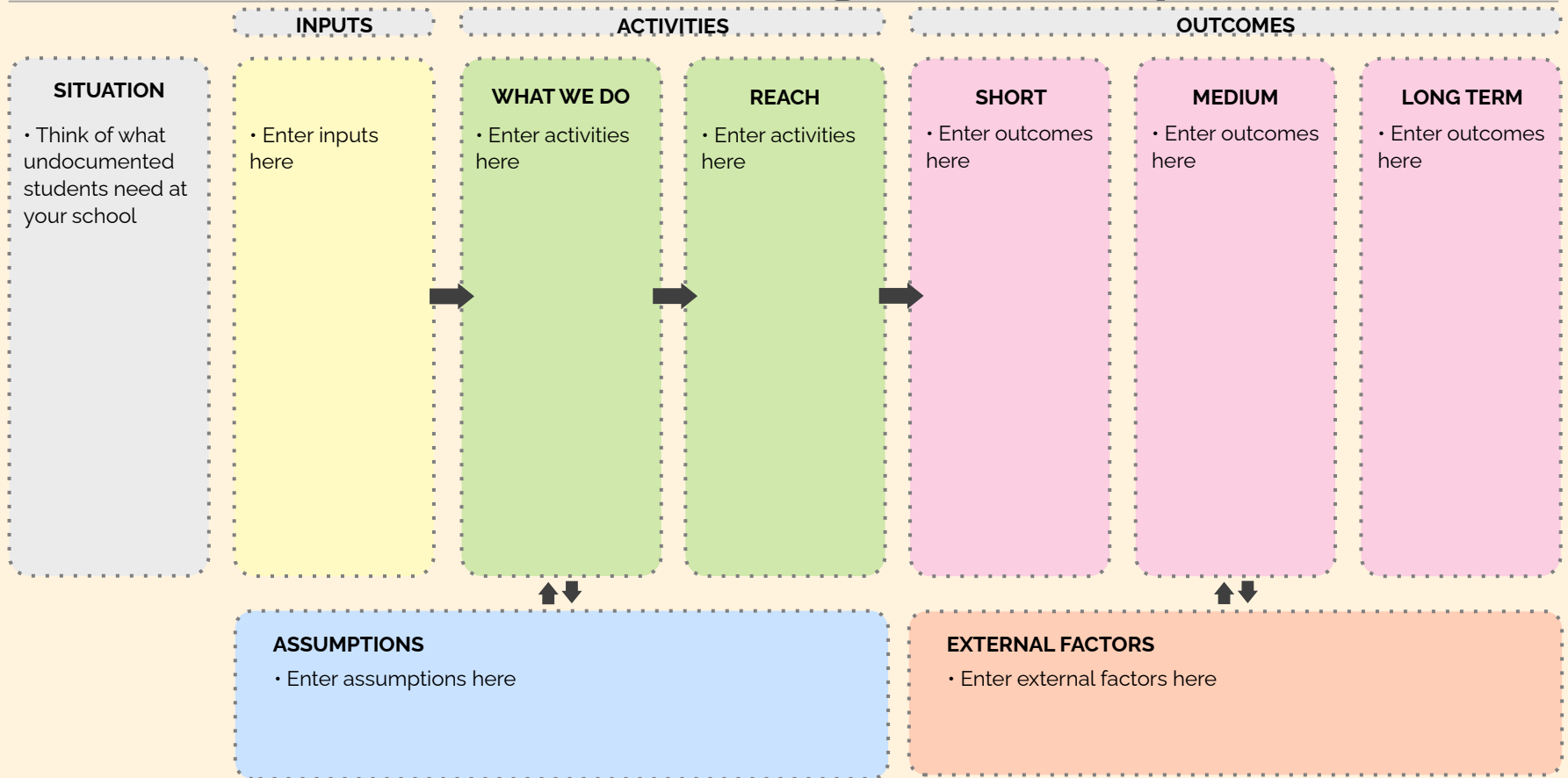

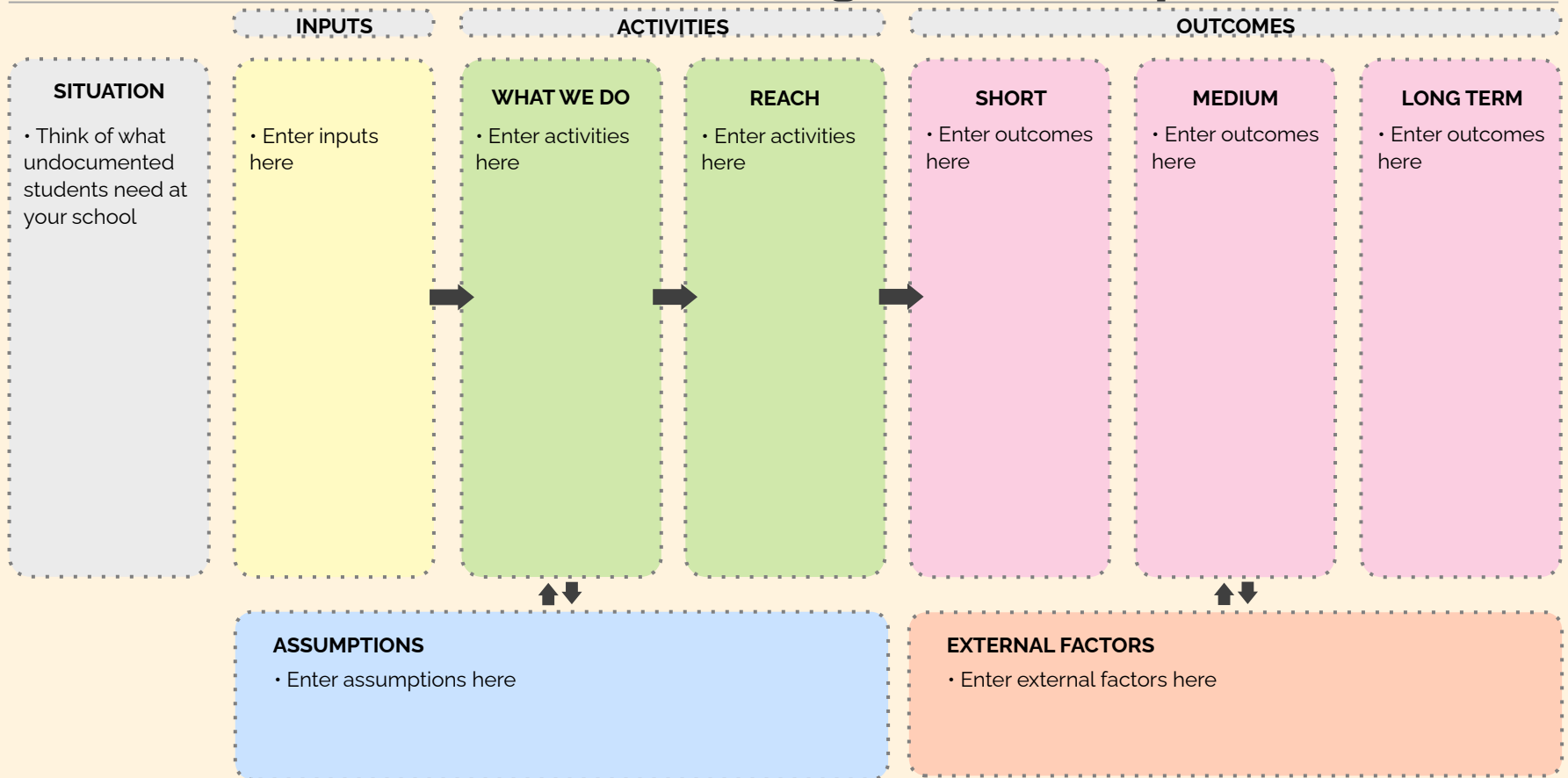
